21. Activities of IQAC during the period:

IQAC Activities during 1st January, 2021 31st Dec. 2021

1. To encourage the students of the institution and those from the other institution of the region, a 10 Days Fencing Coaching Camp has been organized during 04-13 Jan.,2021 with NIS Coaches in the college campus in association with Office of the District Sports Officers and Anirban Fencing Sports Academy inaugurated by Mr. Lakhya Konwar, (Member Secy. State Level Advisory Committee, Dept. of Sports and Youth Welfare; Vice-president, All India Athletic Federation & Gen. Secretary, Assam Olympic Association.).
2. Under Gyan Vriksha Mission, the National Science Day on 28.02.2021 was Observed at Kordoiguri High School, Kordoiguri; Tinsukia, Assam where a Science Model Competition was organized. 7 groups of students participated in the competition and 75 students and teachers gathered in the occasion.
3. The Admission process is done in Fully Online Mode during the session using the Electronic Content Management Software (ECMS) developed by DeeTech Sollution.
4. A Digital Platform (ZOOM) was purchased for smooth running of regular classes, meetings and to organize periodic seminars, workshops in online mode. Teachers also used other Virtual platforms like google meet, Google Classrooms including Zoom to continue regular classes.
5. In view of prevailing Covid19 Situation the Principal was requested to introduce a separate COVID MANAGEMENT SYSTEM and to allocate separate fund. Separate Budget is allocated in Annual College Budget for Covid Situation. A COVID MANAGEMENT BODY was formed and other infrastructures like Sanitization Tunnel, Hand Sanitization Machines were also installed at different places of the college to meet the challenges of Covid19 Situation. It is also made mandatory of wearing mask in the college campus for all.
6. To enhance employability of the students by providing them holistic education, some Add-on /Value Based /Skill Based/Vocational Certificate Courses have been introduced in 2021-22 session such as Certificate Courses on Rural Development (under Political Science Department), Pre-primary & Primary Teacher Training, Weaving & Cutting, Knitting and Dress Making (Under Education Dept.), Hindi Conversation (under Hindi Dept.), Yoga for Spiritual Development (Under Dept. of Philosophy and Sanskrit), Functional English: Creative and Communication (Under English Dept.), Entrepreneurship Development in Small Scale Industries (Under Economics Dept.) etc.
7. Online Feedback Collection (Regular) and Prompt follow up action has been taken by the IQAC and Authority during for the session 2020-2021. Students Feedback (669 students responses) was collected during June, 2021 and Alumnae Feedback (170 responses), Guardian Feedback (200 responses), Teachers Feedback (36 responses), Employees Feedback (10 responses) has been collected during November, 2021.
8. An online Students satisfaction Survey has been done among outgoing students by the IQAC during the month of September, 2021 where 267 out of 269 (99.26%) students participated.
9. A Mid-term Feedback has also been collected from students of all semesters to monitor and to take measures on academic matters during December, 2020 after unlock of Covid Phase. Another Feedback has been collected and analyzed during December 2021.
10. On 26.10.2021, an Academic Audit has been done for the Academic Year, 2019-2020 by inviting External Evaluator Professor Jogen Kalita, Former Director, UGC-HRDC and Ex-Director of CDC, Gauhati University.
11. A Voting Awareness Programme was organised on 03.03.2021 in association with Dist. Administration where 300 (approx.) students and 25 teachers participated.
12. IQAC coordinator of the college Dr. Budul Ch. Das shared the experiences with a team of Makum College, Makum regarding the matter of preparation of AQAR for NAAC Accreditation and has given a preliminary roadmap plan to the team for the same from 12 PM to 3 PM on 12.03.2021.

students and 14 Teachers Participated.

22. Activities of Student Counseling and Guidance Cell

The College has two Cells related to the Students Counselling and Guidance viz. Academic Performance Monitoring and Counseling Cell and Career Counseling and Support Cell.

Usually the institution has a policy of identification of advanced and slow learners through Academic Performance Monitoring and Counseling Cell (APMC). However during the covid period, although the real time identification was not possible to execute, the IQAC along with the college administration in association with Students Union members did personal verification related to their problems in academics through virtual mode and relief initiatives were taken for those who were found affected due to the pandemic situation.

The other cell i.e. Career Counseling and Support Cell, and IQAC during the year performed the following activity related to career counseling and guidance to students:

1. The IQAC provide a list of 37 students to ICT academy for Virtual Off campus Placement Opportunity Drive given by Tech Mahindra (Business Process Services) during July-Aug, 2020 at the time of Covid Pandemic situation.

2. A Power Seminar on "Job Skills for New Normal Scenario" held on 26/12/2020 in association with ICT Academy, Chennai where 126 students participated.

3. A Cooking Workshop was organised on 22.02.2021 where 21 students participated.

4. A total Number of 126 final semester Students of the college have been registered under National Career Service Portal (NCS) under Ministry of Labour and Employment of Govt. of India during 18 June-29 July, 2021 by the IQAC.

5. A virtual Career Awareness Programme was organised in association with EIRC of ICSI on 22.07.2021 where 137 students of the college have participated.

6. A Power Seminar on Women the Power of Moving on Up has been organised in association with ICT Academy, Chennai at 11 am on 25.09.2021 where 326 (Approx) students of the college participated.

7. A Career Awareness Programme was organised on 11.12.2021 at 12 pm in Room No. 2 of the college in Blended Mode in association with Success Torch.

8. A workshop on Art and Craft has been held during 13-18 December, 2021 under the initiative of Teachers Unit and Womens Studies and Development Cell, Womens College, Tinsukia.

9. A Week Long Career Counselling Programme was organised by IQAC and Dept. of Commerce during 13-18 December, 2021 for the students of the college by inviting external experts.

10. Tata Consultancy Services Youth Employability Training Programme started on 18.09.2021 where 43 students participated.

23. Extension Activities during the period:

Teachers and students of Womens college, Tinsukia under the banner of NSS, NCC and Womens studies and development cell organized few extension activities in the neighbourhood community time to time. There were few online awareness programme also organized to sensitized students in issues like protection of environment, health and hygiene and legal awareness programme.

On 8th March, NSS and WSDC organized a legal awareness programme in adopted village(Itakhuli Block) in collaboration with District Legal Services Authority. These programmes helped the students to aware about their responsibilities as well as the villagers learn about their rights and to enjoy their rights with legal protection.

The NSS Unit donated a ladies toilet in Khageswar Bazar area of Tinsukia district. The toilet was inaugurated by the principal of the college on 7th July, 2021.

On 4th and 5th June, 2021- plantation in by pass area of Tinsukia where total total-27 saplings planted by the volunteers and teachers of the college.

On 21/9/2021- Mega Covid 19 vaccination camp was organized by the NSS Unit and IQAC of the college.

Cleanliness drive and plogging was run organized on 16th October, 2021. 11 Volunteers cleaned the road in Durgabari area and collected 4 bags of plastic wastes and disposed through TSK Municipal board.

A voluntary Blood Donation camp was organized by the NSS Unit on 23rd October, 2021. Total 37 unit blood collected and deposited in Blood Bank, AMCH.

A composite weaving centre has been inaugurated on 23rd October, 2021 at new campus of the college in Janumukh village. In this centre about 50 women are getting training in first phase.

A workshop on Vermicompost processing was organised by NSS Unit in college pavilion on 29th December, 2021. 30 volunteers were trained in the workshop by expert Mr. Neeraj Pareek of Tinsukia.

An online workshop on road safety was organised by NSS Unit in collaboration with Honda motor on 3rd Dec, 2021 and 110 volunteers participated in this workshop.

30 volunteers participated in a Breast cancer awareness programme jointly organised by NSS Unit and WSDC, WCT on 10/12/2021

54 Volunteers joined in a rally organised by District administration and social welfare dept. of Tinsukia to protect women from domestic violence. The rally was organised on 6th Dec, 2021.

NSS Unit in collaboration with NCC Wing of the college took out a rally on 16th Dec, 2021 to observe victory day and to aware the people about the heroic role of Indian Army in Indo-Pak war in 1971. 53 volunteers joined the rally.
