ACTION TAKEN REPORT Green Campus Initiatives

Women's College, Tinsukia

As a part of the Green Campus Policy of the institution following programs have been conducted successfully on sustainable basis in the College campus and in the nearby regions.

1) "Go for Green": As a part of this initiative, every Tuesday is observed as the Zero Emission Day for the College fraternity. On that day every member of the college family (students/ Teachers/ office staff) discard vehicles that uses fossil fuel and instead use non-polluting means of conveyance (viz. E-Rickshaw, Bicycle etc.) to the college. On that day of the week all diesel operated generators are kept in shut down conditions and only digital inverters are used as electricity back-up.

- 2) Minimize emission of Greenhouse gas: The College, as a part of its Green Policy has shifted its dependence from Diesel Generators to Digital Inverters for electricity backups. It uses diesel generators only during operation of Computer laboratories and during functions in the Auditorium. This has resulted in decrease in its emission of CO₂ (greenhouse gas). At present the College has 13 digital inverters with a total output load of 20.2 KVA at different sections.
- 3) **Minimize consumption of Electricity**: It has been decided to convert all Incandescent and CFL Electric bulbs in the campus to LED bulbs. This has been done with a view to decreasing electricity consumption, which in turn would reduce pressure on the environment. Due to its longevity, the LED bulbs help reduce e-waste generation.

4) Advancement of working hour in the office in order to maximize use of Daylight: In Assam the Sun rises at least one hour earlier than the western part of the country. It also sets earlier accordingly. In order to avail maximum Sunlight, it is required to advance the office hour, which the college authority has been doing since 2018.





Fig. 2: Office order in connection with advancement of working hour at the College.
