Action Taken on Feedback of Teachers (2019-20)

A Feedback Analysis Report of the session 2019-20 has been prepared on the basis of the responses received from 30 numbers of teachers of the college. As per findings of the feedback, actions in the requisite areas have been taken as given below.

1. ACADEMIC & TEACHING					
Sl. No.	Findings	Action Taken			
1	In this year, the percentage of teachers who prepare PPTs for their allotted courses is increased to 93.3% from 87.5% (previous year). Again the teachers who use ICT/ Multimedia facility in their classes are remarkably increased to 96.7% from 48.33% of 2018-19.	Following steps have been taken to encourage 100% teachers in using ICT/Multimedia facility in their classes: a) Tutorial Videos regarding use of online platform like ZOOM etc. were shared with teachers and students. b) Teachers are being continuously encouraged to use Applications like X-recorder in preparing E-content etc. c) Monitoring of online classes have been done to encourage the good performers and to ensure quality of the same. d) Teachers are encouraged to increase their number of PPTs/E-contents etc.			
2	The problem encountered by teachers in teaching-learning process is remarkably decreased to 6.7% from 33.33% (previous year).	Necessary steps have been taken to provide at least one classroom with ICT facility to all Departments.			

2. INFRASTRUCTURE AND LEARNING RESOURCES

1	Instead of 33.33% teachers of 2018-19, in this session 30% teachers opine that books/journals/reading materials related to their departments are not sufficient in the library.	Due to introduction of CBCS in UG level in the session 2019-20, the issue has resurfaced, despite our best efforts. The Librarian has been asked to ensure immediate augmentation of new books by collecting list of required books from each Head of the Departments. Processes have already been initiated in this regard.			
2	In comments and suggestions, some teachers opines:a) Need more classrooms.b) Infrastructure should be improved.	Initiative has been taken in this regard under RUSA 2.0 infrastructural Grant.
