

## Action Taken on Feedback of Teachers (2020-21)

### WOMEN'S COLLEGE, TINSUKIA

A Feedback Analysis Report of the session 2020-21 has been prepared on the basis of the responses received from the teachers of the college. As per findings of the feedback, actions in the requisite areas have been taken as given below.

#### 1. ACADEMIC & TEACHING

Sl. No.	Findings	Action Taken
1	This year, the percentage of teachers who prepare PPTs for their allotted courses has increased to 94.4% from 93.3% of previous year.	We have been encouraging all teachers to use ICT/Multimedia facilities in their classes and to increase their number of PPTs/E-contents etc.
2	The problem encountered by teachers in teaching-learning process is observed 11.1% instead of 6.7% (previous year).	Necessary steps have been taken to reduce inconveniences faced by teachers.

#### 2. INFRASTRUCTURE AND LEARNING RESOURCES

Sl. No.	Findings	Action Taken
1	41.70% teachers opine that books/journals/reading materials related to their departments are not sufficient in the library.	Due to introduction of CBCS in UG level in the session 2019-20, and also due to COVID induced adverse situations, the issues remained. The Librarian has been asked to discuss with departmental heads and to ensure immediate augmentation of new books. Processes have already been initiated in this regard.

#### 3. GOVERNANCE, LEADERSHIP AND MANAGEMENT:

Sl. No.	Findings	Action Taken
1	Teachers' Satisfaction to the administrative process of the college sustains in 100%. Although 36.1% & 52.8% teachers provide 'Excellent' & 'Good' grade to the educational environment of the college, 11.1 % teachers provide the grade of 'Satisfactory' to the same.	Continuous efforts are on to maintain a good academic environment. Administrative processes have been made friendly to both students and teachers.

Sl. No.	Findings	Action Taken
1	Arrangement for Students' Placement	The <i>Career Counselling and Placement Cell</i> of the college has been reconstituted and necessary steps have been initiated to make it dynamic and effective.
2	Increase students' enrichment facilities	More than 17 Add on courses have been introduced in this regard. Efforts are on to enhance such facilities.
3	Extracurricular activities should be encouraged	Extracurricular and Co-curricular activities are encouraged. Fencing coaching has been provided on regular basis by a NIS coach. There is a permanent Music teacher in the college to provide coaching on Modern vocal music.
