1. OFFICIAL WORKS

1	Observed that 87.5% (64.3% in previous year) employees keep records of their official tasks in both Soft and hard copies.	The 4 th Grade staffs of both office and library have no record to keep in soft version. All Grade III staffs (clerical) maintain their records both in hard and soft version.		
2	37.5% employees state that they have not been provided any sort of training of official work.	Efforts are on to provide them with necessary training.		
3	62.5%(14.3% in previous year) employees think that they are overburdened.	Steps have been taken to fill up the vacant posts.		
4	50% (21.4% in previous year) employees opine that they have to work overtime.	To resolve the problem, workloads have been distributed among staff. In an understaffed office, it is one issue that the authority has not been able to resolve properly. Moreover at times the enquiry/ notification/ orders from higher authority comes via E mail/ WhatsApp in the evening asking for immediate/ urgent response. Realizing the urgency of the task the office staff, including the principal has to work overtime to get the assigned job done. We are happy to work overtime with a view to providing services to the nation.
