Theories on Multiculturalism

Two major theories- Melting Pot and Salad Bowl

Salad Bowl-This model describes a heterogeneous society where people coexist but retain at least some unique characteristics of their traditional culture. In this model, different cultures are brought together like ingredients in a salad, but these individual cultures retain their own flavours, instead of merging into a single homogeneous culture

Melting Pot – This model proposes that various immigrant groups will tend to “melt together,” deserting their individual cultures and ultimately becoming fully assimilated into the predominant society.
