# Summary Report of Student Satisfaction Survey Women's College, Tinsukia Session-2018-2019 

During the session 2018-19 the Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) has been conducted by the IQAC of the college. A standard format has been devised for the same in consultation with the various stakeholders. The survey was done during the month of April-May, 2019 which was in offline mode. The outcomes have been analyzed and a consolidated report has been prepared. It has been decided that after placing it before the college authority and the Governing Body, it could be uploaded in the college website.

## Report:

As per norm, feedbacks have been taken in this survey only from the outgoing students ( $6^{\text {th }}$ Semester). A total of 280 students i.e. $93 \%$ of the outgoing students have submitted their feedbacks. In the satisfaction survey following aspects has been addressed and questions have been put to judge on a 10 point scale. The aspects were -

1. Overall Academic Performance of the college.
2. Overall grading on Teaching Quality.
3. Student friendly environment in the college.
4. Library Facility of the college.
5. Administrative Office of the college.
6. Students Safety \& Security in the college campus.
7. Cleanliness of the campus.
8. Extra-curricular activities.
9. Career Counseling \& Placement
10. Hostel of the college.
11. Other Facilities in the college.
12. Principal of the college.

On such aspects, it has been observed in the survey that -

a) $15.7 \%$ students have given a score 10 .
b) $28.6 \%$ students have given a score 9 .

d) $12.5 \%$ students have given a score 7 .
e) $8.2 \%$ students have given a score 6 .

12. $90.71 \%$ of the participating students have given a score between 10 to 6 in category of Principal of the college out of which -
a) $42.9 \%$ students have given a score 10 .
b) $25.0 \%$ students have given a score 9 .
c) $14.3 \%$ students have given a score 8 .
d) $4.3 \%$ students have given a score 7 .
e) $4.3 \%$ students have given a score 6 .

The results of the SSS appears to be satisfactory as more than $90 \%$ students have given good grades to the college on majority of the aspects covered by the survey. However, the college administration takes serious note on the dissatisfaction shown by the students on some aspects and has decided to put systematic approach so that it can be minimized in the days to come.
