VASU (hereinafter referred as 'First Party' the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or contest shall include its successor – in office, administrators and assigns)

Women's College, Tinsukia, Durgabari, Rangagora Road, Tinsukia, Assam the 'Second Party', and represented herein by Dr. Rajib Bordoloi, Principal, Women's College, Tinsukia (here in after referred to as 'Second Party', company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or contest shall include its successors- in office, administrator and assigns)

(First Party and Second Party are herein jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually and 'Party')

WHEREAS

A) First party is a Technical Educational Institution named:

INDIAN INSTITUTE OF HANDLOOM TECHNOLOGY, JAWAHAR NAGAR, KHANAPARA, GUWAHATI

B) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of the resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities

C) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research

D) Both the parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interest

E) **Women's College, Tinsukia**, the Second Party is engaged in Skill Based Training, Education and Research.

F) **Women's College, Tinsukia**, the Second Party is a College dealing with Education and also in handloom fabric weaving/manufacturing based at Bazaltoli Gaon, Tinsukia, Assam.

NOW THEREFORE, INCONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU,

THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSES-1

> CO-OPERATION:

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potentials opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching/training system, keeping in minds the needs of the industry and the Second Party.
- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents the Definitive Documents as may be required to give effect to the action completed in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall present the entire understanding as to

the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter thereof.

CLAUSE-2

➤ SCOPE OF THE MOU:

2.1 The budding Textile Technocrats from the Institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the students community to enhance their skills and knowledge.

2.2 **Curriculum Designs:** Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching/training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.

2.3 **Industrial Training and Visits:** Industry and Institution interaction will give an insight into the latest developments/requirement of the industries; the Second Party to permit the faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its group companies and also involve in Industrial Training programmes for the First Party. The industrial training and exposure provided to the students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. The Second Party will provide its Labs/workshop/industrial sites for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.

2.4 **Research and Development:** Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities in the fields of Handloom & Textiles.

2.5 **Skill Development programs:** Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.

2.6 **Guest Lectures:** Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lecturers to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.

2.7 **Faculty Development Programs:** Second Party trains the Faculties of First Party for imparting training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.

2.8 **Placement of trained students:** Second Party will actively engage to hold the delivery of the training and placement of students of the First Party into internships/job; and will facilitate placement for at least 10 % of the students. The Second Party will itself absorb at least 10% of the trained students.

2.9 Both parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programmes of the terms specified herein.

2.10 There is no financial commitment on the part of the **Indian Institute of Handloom Technology, Jawahar Nagar, Khanapara, Guwahati-22** the First Party to take up any programme mentioned in the MOU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

CLAUSE-3

➤ **INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY:**

3.1 Nothing contained in the MOU shall, Express grant, implication, Estoppels or otherwise, create I either Party and right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectuals property including but not limited to know-how, inventions, parties, copy rights and designs of the other Party.

CLAUSE-4

➤ **VALIDITY:**

4.1 This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period 5 (five) years from the date of execution of MoU with **Women's College, Tinsukia**, the Second Party, as they case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of Training Partner or **Women's College, Tinsukia**, the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc. shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU.


4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days; notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

CLAUSE-5

➤ **RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES:**

5.1 It is expressly agreed that **First Party** and **Second Party** are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorised to use other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, express or implied, on behalf of the other party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation of application of the MOU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the




arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of Guwahati.
