



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

1. **Sub:** Waste Collection, Transportation and Recycling from the Women's College, Tinsukia.
2. **Parties:**

This MoU has been signed between the Women's College, Tinsukia (Party-1), to be represented by the Principal of the college and the Care North East Foundation (Party-2), a NGO dedicated to Waste Management in the North-East, to be represented by its Director.

This is to agree and confirm that CARE North East Foundation (CNEF) – a registered Non-Government Organization under the companies Act, working in Environmental Services and its partner E-Waste Recycler United Global Trust – Guwahati is approved by Central Pollution Control Board.

As per available documentary evidence it has been confirmed that M/S United Global Trust has given consent & permission, as a consortium partner, to CARE North East Foundation, Borguri, Tinsukia 786126, for collection, separation, transportation and storage of E-waste from any E waste generating source in Tinsukia District.

3. **Scopes:**

- This MoU will come into effect immediately after signing by the two concerned parties and will remain effective for one year from the date of signing. On expiry of its term, the two parties can renew it, on mutual agreement, for another term.
- This MoU will enable CNEF (on behalf of United Global Trust) to periodically collect and transport the E-waste to its designated storage center for further transportation for recycling to relevant locations.
- As a part of this MoU, Women's College, Tinsukia will pay minimal charges for transporting the same to CNEF (the amount to be mutually agreed upon based on quantity and destination).
- Both parties will maintain a record on E-waste in terms of kg for any reference.
