

Action Taken on Feedback of Alumnae (2022-23)

A Feedback Analysis Report of the session 2022-23 has been prepared on the basis of the responses received from the alumnae of the college. As per findings of the feedback, actions in the requisite areas have been taken as given below.

1. MEMBERSHIP AND CONTRIBUTION

Sl. No.	Findings	Action Taken
1	It is observed that 27.2% (42.7% in 2021-22) alumnae who participated in the feedback process are not registered member of the Alumnae Association of the college.	President and Secretary of the Association have been asked to look into the matter and expedite the process of alumnae registration with a target of 100% registration of the alumnae.
2	73.6% alumnae opine that they visit the college frequently.	We have urged the alumnae to visit their Alma-Mater frequently and to offer feedbacks and suggestions for its improvement.
3	63.2%(28.2% in 2021-22) alumnae informs that they have attended alumnae meet arranged in the college.	Steps have been taken to increase more participation of Alumnae in their association's meetings.
4	47.2% alumnae have opined that they have contributed to the college for its overall development, directly or indirectly.	There is enough scope for improvement in this aspect. It has been communicated to the Alumnae association that in present day scenario, the college requires greater support from the Alumnae Association

1	Score on the <i>overall performance</i> of the college is observed- Excellent - 47.2% Good - 47.2%	The college administration, with active support from its teaching and non-teaching faculties, has been doing everything possible to earn good reputation among its stake holders.

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2	Score on the Teachers of the college is observed- Excellent- 63.2% (In 2021-22 it was 57.3%) Good- 32.8%	The college administration is always in touch with its teaching faculties and has been guiding them with strategic plans to enhance their performances so as to earn good reputation among stakeholders.
