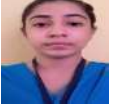

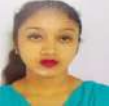

Notwithstanding the issue of Admit Card ,the Executive Council shall have the right for any reason which may appear to them sufficient to cancel the admission of any candidate to any examination whether before during or after the examination. The Executive Council may also debar a candidate from appearing at any subsequent University examination or examinations. **The decision of the Executive Council in all cases shall be final.**
